## **Stockgrowers Memorial Scholarship**

**Purpose:** This scholarship is offered to encourage participation in the field of agriculture. Funds for this scholarship include donations in memory and in honor of men and women who have contributed to the livestock industry in Wallowa County.

**Eligibility:**

- To be considered, a student must be enrolled in a school of agriculture, school of forestry, or other natural resource related area of study beyond the high school level.
- Applicants should be residents of Wallowa County and should have attended school in Wallowa County.
- Both graduating high school seniors and students presently enrolled in post high school programs are eligible for consideration. (*Preference given to applicants with at least college sophomore standing.*)

**Application Process:**

Complete the scholarship application form and return it with sealed letters of recommendation, proof of post high school program enrollment and a copy of present school transcripts to the following address,

**Selection Criteria:**

1. Applicant must have demonstrated qualities of scholarship and leadership in school and community.
2. Applicants must complete an interview with the Wallowa County Agricultural Resource Foundation's Scholarship Committee, in-person interviews are preferred.
3. Two (2) letters of recommendation, one from a present or former employer is required. It is preferred that letters not be from relatives of the applicant.
4. Financial need may be considered, but is not a selection requirement.
5. An official copy of the applicant's present school transcripts must be included for review.
6. The scholarship will only apply to an accredited four year college with a plan for a four year degree program or graduate program, or an accredited program at a community college, business school, or alternative program which meets scholarship committee approval.
7. Applicant will supply a copy of their post secondary school acceptance letter(s) or a copy of present college transcripts to provide proof of college enrollment.
